The meeting has no specific theme and papers are invited that cover all aspects of the history of science, technology and medicine.

No speaker may present papers in more than one session at this conference (this restriction does not apply to the designated Outreach and Education sessions). Papers may be co-authored or co-presented, but each paper will receive an equal time allocation (usually from 20 to 30 minutes including questions.) Presenters in one session are welcome to commentate or chair in another.

Prospective participants should submit

- an abstract of no more than 250 words with no footnotes and comprehensible to a non-specialist audience.
- full contact details
- Details of any specific audio visual requirements for your talk
- Your proposal should be sent as a single electronic document to bshs2011programme@bshs.org.uk.

In order that we can publicise the conference as effectively as possible, we will assume that in submitting an abstract, each participant is granting us the right to publish its content on the Society's website and elsewhere: if you do not wish your abstract to be publicised, please advise us explicitly. Where appropriate, we may contact you seeking further information for use in conference press releases.
