Venue The conference venue is the Marc Fitch Historical Institute, 1 Salisbury Road, Leicester, LE1 7QR. This is short (5-10 mins) walk from Leicester railway station. See <http://www2.le.ac.uk/departments/urbanhistory/about/facilities> for information and links to maps and directions. Dedicated parking is limited and preference will be given to those who require it for mobility reasons. Pay and display street parking and car parks are located close to the venue.

Programme.
